a lift for network house

We want to continue to teach the Bible, equip people for service, worship God in the freedom of the Holy Spirit, reach out to others in His power, serve the poor and broken in society, express unity with the rest of the church and live as God's missionary people.

lift proposal

Our next priority for the building is to install a lift to ensure that anyone with access needs can make use of the whole space.

This will currently benefit:

- People with access needs
- Discovery Zone (children and teams),
- Network Play (toddler mums with pushchairs)
- External Conference Users

The lift also represents a sensible investment in the fabric of the building and makes us fully compliant with current regulations. We have taken professional advice from specialist companies to ensure the best possible standard of construction. The cost of installing a lift to all floors is approximately £30,000.

By deciding to give to this project you will help ensure that no one is excluded from future church events on the basis of access needs.

All the money given will be designated for this project and will not be spent on anything else. When we have all the necessary funds we will start the development. Our prayer is that we can get this project completed within the year 2010.

Giving by cash or cheque

Giving by both cash or cheque and standing order

Gift Aid

Filling in the Gift Aid Declaration will enable us to claim back from the Inland Revenue, approximately £28 for every £100 given (this being the amount of tax at the basic rate you will have paid on the money you are giving). As you can imagine, this provides a **significant** increase in the church's income in return for very little paperwork.

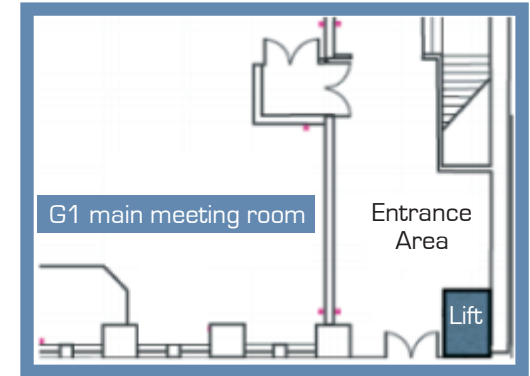

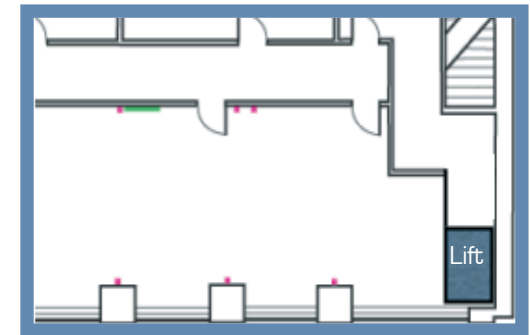

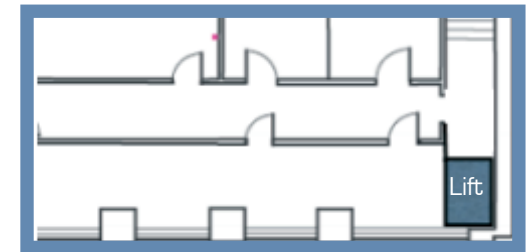
